8. So Joshua and the whole army moved out to attack Ai. He chose twenty thousand of his best fighting men and sent them out at night (                    )
9. Two days after they made the treaty with the Gibeonites, the Israelites heard that they were neighbors, living near them. (                    )
10. Then Joshua put the kings to death and exposed their bodies on four poles, and they were left hanging on the poles until evening. (                    )
