9. When they came to the threshing floor of Nakon, Uzzah reached out and touched the ark of God, because the oxen stumbled. The Lord’s anger burned against Uzzah because of his irreverent act; therefore God struck him down, and he died there beside the ark of God. ()
10. David also defeated the Moabites. He made them lie down on the ground and measured them off with a length of cord. Every two lengths of them were allowed to live, and the third length was put to death. ()
